Assessment	<p>Hardware and software compatibility: Check they meet the Windows 11 Pro requirements</p>	<p>Application compatibility: Ensure critical applications are compatible with Windows 11 Pro</p>
Planning	<p>Deployment strategy: Decide on a strategy (e.g., phased rollout, pilot testing)</p>	<p>Training and communication: Prepare training materials and inform your team</p>
Pilot	<p>Pilot testing: Test the upgrade with a small user group and address issues</p>	<p>Feedback and adjustments: Gather feedback and make necessary changes</p>
Deployment	<p>Phased rollout: Gradually upgrade all users, starting with less critical systems</p>	<p>Support and monitoring: Provide user support and monitor for issues</p>
Post-deployment	<p>Review and optimise: Review the process and optimise based on feedback</p>	<p>Ongoing support: Ensure continuous support and maintenance</p>

This timeline can vary depending on the size of your organisation, the complexity of your IT environment, and the resources available.⁵ Taking action now and planning thoroughly can help ensure a smooth transition to Windows 11 Pro.
